- Co-lead an activity group for children between the ages of birth to 18 years.
- Provide fun, functional and stimulating activities based on a 4-week curriculum for preschoolers, school-aged children and youth groups designed to help enhance self-esteem, problem solving capacities, peer interactions and parent/caregiver relationships.
- Set-up and clean-up activities and serve a healthy snack that is provided.
- Participate in weekly pre-planning meetings (via email, telephone, face-to-face) with co-facilitator(s) and be part of debriefing with team at end of evening.
